Year 11 week-by-week curriculum overview 2020-21

Students are working towards two GCSEs: English Language and English Literature. The government requires students to re-take English Language if they do not achieve a pass (grade 4 or above) in either of their English GCSEs.

This year, year 11 students will study a slightly reduced programme for English Literature. As a department, we have taken the decision to "drop" the poetry anthology, after extensive review of the best interests of our students. Students will continue to be examined on Much Ado About Nothing (Shakespeare), Jekyll and Hyde (R.L. Stevenson), An Inspector Calls (Priestley) and an unseen poetry analysis and comparison question.

English Language is unaffected by the GCSE changes and students will be examined in two exam papers, on unseen text extracts.
