Uniform at NIA

The basics

- Trousers must be tailored and charcoal grey. Black trousers, leggings or jeans must not be worn
- · Pupils' skirts must be grey and knee-length or longer
- Pupils should wear a white shirt tucked into skirt or trousers
- Pupils should wear a school tie
- Pupils should wear a blazer with the NIA logo
- A plain grey, v neck sweater is optional (NIA logo optional)
- Shoes should be black leather. Black plimsolls & trainers are not part of the NIA uniform
- Boots should not be worn at school
- No jewellery should be worn however a small stud earring at the bottom of each ear is acceptable
- Head-scarves should be black, navy blue or grey only and plain material

Hair and makeup

- Pupils should not wear make up
- · Hair styles should be appropriate for a learning environment
- Hair should natural in colour, always check with staff before paying for an expensive treatment as coloured braids etc are not part of school policy
- · Where necessary, hair accessories should be simple and plain
- Nail varnish should not be worn at school
- · Pupils should not wear false acrylic or temporary nails

Remember

- · Mobile phones should never be seen or heard within school
- Chewing gum should not be brought into school
