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The student learning agreement is intended to give students a clear understanding of what they can expect from NIA Sixth Form and what will be expected from them in return. Under this agreement, NIA Sixth form will endeavour to provide:

- A friendly, caring and supportive environment where every student matters.
- A Head of Sixth Form, an Assistant Head of Sixth form and a Tutor, who will monitor your progress and provide guidance and assistance in setting targets for improvements.
- Guidance to achieve the most effective use of study time.
- Guidance when applying for university.
- Access to expert careers advice.
- The opportunity to take part in leisure and extra-curricular activities.
- Annual opportunities for your parents/guardians to come into school to discuss your progress.
- One set of written reports each year and interim assessments where appropriate.

As a student in NIA Sixth Form you are expected to:

- Take responsibility for your own learning with support from your subject teachers, Tutors, Head of Sixth Form and Assistant Head of Sixth Form.
- Demonstrate a mature, honest and hardworking attitude that allows you to make the most of your time in Sixth Form.
- Maintain the standards of behaviour set out in the Library and Sixth Form Study Areas acceptable use policy.
- Complete your work to the best of your ability.
- Sign up to an Enrichment Pathway and complete all the sessions and additional tasks related to your chosen pathway.
- Meet all deadlines as set by your subject teachers.
- Be proactive in discussing any concerns over your work with your subject teacher, Tutor, Head of Sixth Form or Assistant Head of Sixth Form.
- Use your private study time in school effectively; do not wait to be told.
- Accept that 100% attendance should be the norm and the Head of Sixth Form and Assistant Head of Sixth Form will follow up any unexplained absence.
- Accept all students must remain in the school building to study during periods 1-5, including free periods.
- Arrive in school before 8.45am and attend all lessons on time.

- Accept that lateness will result in action by the Head of Sixth Form and/or the Assistant Head of Sixth Form
- Discuss any situation that may require you to be absent from a lesson or tutorial, with your Tutor, Head of Sixth Form or Assistant Head of Sixth Form.
- Absences from school must be reported, by a parent, to school reception before 9am every day of absence.
- You have undertaken a programme of study and therefore you will be expected to take your examinations. Failure to do so may result in a charge being levied to cover examination costs.
- Respect the individual rights of the school community and behave accordingly to the whole school Code of Conduct.
- Act as a positive role model for the younger students both inside school and out in the community.
- Contribute to the life of Northampton International Academy and its community
- Adhere to the Sixth Form dress code.
- Accept that failure to meet the above conditions may result in you being asked to leave NIA Sixth Form.
