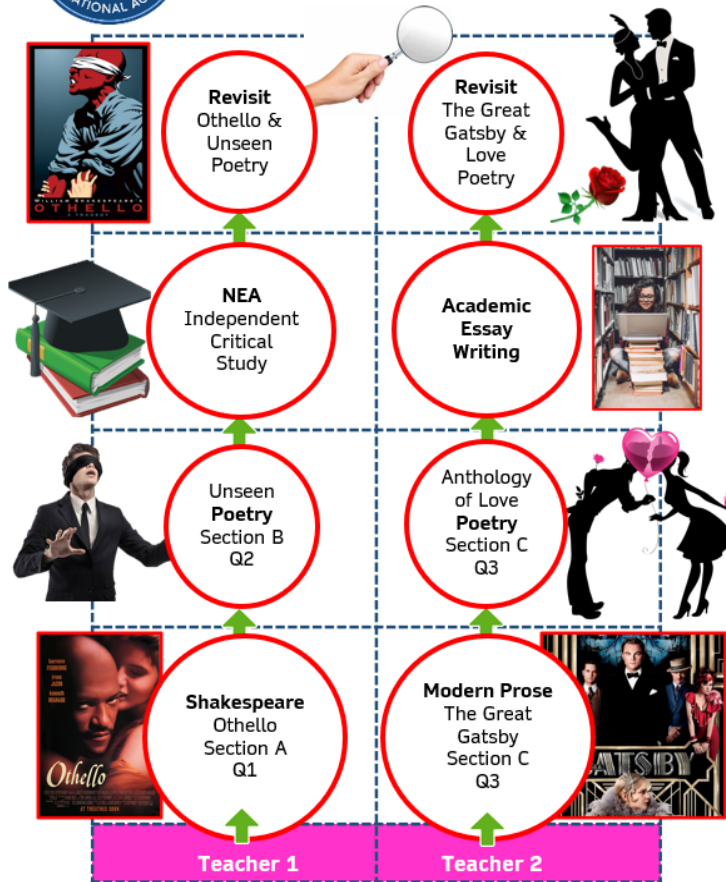


Why Study A Level English Literature?
