Committee Introductions written by our staff leads

In leading on the This Girl Can campaign for the past 3 years, I have supported the promotion of female sport and physical activity at NIA which has been successful due to the calibre of students at NIA, the potential they carry and qualities they possess. I have got our students to support the school (inclusive of the Primary and Secondary phase) in developing promotional material with videos and posters to encourage other students at NIA to get involved in the TGC campaign which have been shared in whole school assemblies, International Women's Day and Transition Day. We have been fortunate enough to arrange for guest speakers to come into the Academy to deliver inspirational talks to our learners including professional athletes and Olympians. Students have been invited to attend talks at the local University of Northampton and engage in workshops lead by professors.

This campaign has been hugely successful since the launch in academic year 21/22, with NIA students representing our Academy as Sports Leaders as well as the campaign having an impact on sports involvement across the Academy. There are now 264 students who are now involved in TGC and Girls Club. Outlined below is data collected in our student voice survey in academic year 23/24:

- 63% of students have joined a sports team at NIA since being part of TGC
- 75% of students have joined a club at NIA since being part of TGC
- 54% of students have started a club outside of school since being part of TGC
- 88% of students stated they are very likely to continue sport when they leave school due to the impact of TGC
- 84% of students who attended Girls Club had not previously been involved

We continue to push the development of our TGC campaign and look forward to upcoming plans and events to grow even more at NIA.
