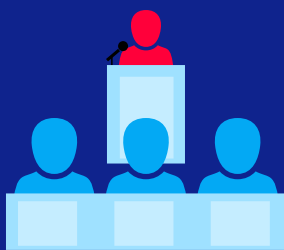


Year 12s Gain Public Speaking Confidence with Future Toolbox!

This is an incredible opportunity to experience university life, stay overnight in halls of residence, develop new skills, and meet new people. Best of all? It's completely free!

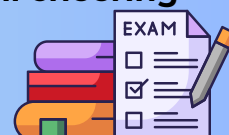
