#### **Attendance**


Our current attendance figures are:

# **Transport and lessons**

#### **NIA6 school minibus service**

Dear Parents/Guardians,

I am writing to confirm arrangements for transporting our pupils and staff between NIA, Barrack Road, and NIA6, Billing Road.

Students will be expected to arrive to their lessons in accordance with their timetables at the beginning of the day.

If they arrive at the wrong campus they will be expected to wait there until break time, at which time the minibus will be available to transport them.

The minibus will also provide a service at lunch time.

At the end of the day, students will be expected to depart as normal from the respective campus.

Prior to opening, we consulted with the Police Safer Routes Team and representatives from the Local Authority to ensure we have a safe route for students who wish to walk between campuses.

We will share this with our students every half term.

We are taking steps to reduce the need for transfer of pupils by moving more lessons to NIA6. Students will be asked to check their timetables for Monday 1<sup>st</sup> December. If you have any questions or need further clarification, please contact NIA6 reception and ask to speak to a member of the NIA6 team. Thank you for your continued support.
