Whilst daily life for Year 5 will feel exactly the same as their primary peers, with routines, learning, playtimes, classrooms, assemblies and all other curricular activities remaining a part of the Primary phase, there will be some changes to distinguish this graduation to Middle School:

Middle School Uniform

Year 5 and Year 6 uniform is:

- Grey trousers / grey skirt / grey dress (not jogging bottoms)
- Grey tights / socks and appropriate black school shoes (not trainers)
- Navy blue sweatshirt (logo available)
- White collared school shirt (long or short sleeved) and House tie

This year we will be issuing all Year 5 children their respective House tie which will be given to them on their first day in September, so there is no need to purchase this in advance. School Timings and Entrance / Exits

Term will start on Monday 5th September and our school timings will revert to 8:45 – 3:15.

Year 5 will be expected to enter the building from the <u>front of the building via the Primary Reception</u> in September. A member of primary staff will be on duty from 8:35 and children will be collected and brought into school at 8:45.

We would encourage any families with children in younger year groups to drop off the younger siblings in the primary playground first and then bring Year 5 children around to the front of the building between 8:45 and 8:50 where they will be allowed to make their way directly to their classrooms.
